A permanent record of every change made to the Tripp-Jones Family Constitution & Bylaws

— maintained by the Secretary

1. Purpose

This Log records every amendment proposed and adopted (or rejected) under Article 34 of the Constitution and Bylaws Article 2. It serves as the authoritative history of how the Constitution has evolved — who proposed each change, when it was voted on, what the vote count was, and what the Constitution said before and after.

This Log is maintained by the Secretary and reviewed by the Parliamentarian before each election cycle to ensure the working copy of the Constitution reflects all adopted amendments.

2. Amendment Process Summary

For reference, the amendment process requires (Article 34 & Bylaws Article 2):

1. A written proposal submitted to the Executive Committee.
2. Formation of a Constitution Amendment Committee (Executive Committee + 4 District Leaders) to review.
3. Notice to the full family at least 30 days before the vote.
4. A two-thirds majority of all valid votes cast, with a minimum quorum of 15 eligible voting members.
5. The Secretary records the amendment and updates the official Constitution within 14 days.

3. Amendment Log

Entries are added by the Secretary after each vote, whether the amendment passes or fails.
